\$5,000 Awards for Middle and High School Students on Long Island



HMTC defines an upstander as a person who stands up for others and does not allow bigotry, hatred, or intolerance to happen without intercession. Every year HMTC honors middle and high school students from across Long Island who have demonstrated the actions of an **Upstander**.

Teachers/Counselors, etc.

Must write a nomination letter about what makes your student an upstander and the reason why they should be honored with this prestigious award.

Students

Must write at least a 500-word essay on what makes him/her/them an upstander using the essay prompt: ***"I have demonstrated the actions of an upstander by..."*** To be eligible to win, students must agree to speak briefly at the awards event about their upstander actions and/or efforts. The essay becomes the property of HMTC and can be used in the media (student name can remain anonymous). At the top of the essay, please include your name, email address, school, and grade.
